KS1: A NEW BOOK FOR THE EMPEROR

KS2: HIDDEN IN PLAIN SIGHT



An investigative journey, exploring the story of William and Ellen Craft (pictured), a couple who evaded slavery by carrying out one of history's most ingenious escapes in 1848.

Passing as a white man travelling with his servant, the two slaves fled their masters in a thrilling adventure of deception and intrigue.





Presented with a box of documents, clues and evidence, children work together to discover the real-life story of William and Ellen Craft. Taking on different roles as the adventure unfolds this dramatic investigation places children at the centre of the debate around race, racism and the anti-slavery movement.

KS2: ARTY'S BROKEN HEART



Arty's Broken Heart is an investigation for children into their hearts and how to better maintain their health. Our creative combination of science and movement enables pupils to find value in improving their health outcomes, increase knowledge of the heart and develop a more positive attitude towards physical activity.

In 2020, the original edition of this programme 'City Beat' was a great success, delivered both in person and, during the lockdown, digitally.

The key areas of the Arty's Broken Heart box set include:
